

With Georg Philipp Telemann's Concerto in D-major we introduce a magnificent and masterly piece of music for wind-instruments.

Qualified Horn players will welcome this publication, students will thankfully regard it as new material for their studies, and chamber orchestras will enlarge their repertoire with an effective concerto.

Our edition follows the parts which are in the possession of the State- and University Library of Hesse. The arrangements made consisted of the filling in of the basso continuo, the adding of dynamic accents, and the changing of the first Viola part into a second Violin part.
