

**Winteregg, S: Pastiche**

About the composition:

Pastiche derives its motivic material from "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" by Martin Luther, and each movement is based on a different phrase of this Lutheran hymn. While the appropriate phrase is presented in its original form in each movement, the phrase is also found in its inversion, retrograde, and retrograde inversion as well as undergoes motivic development. In other words, each phrase becomes the kernel from which each movement grows. Pastiche was written for and dedicated to the Wittenberg University Horn Choir, Richard Chenoweth, director.

Performance Note:

The eighth note stays constant through all meter changes.

About the Composer:

Steven Winteregg is currently an instructor of brass and director of the brass choir at Wittenberg University as well as Composer-in-Residence at Cedarville college. Having won four awards in composition, he is also tubist and arranger for the Dayton Philharmonic Brass Quintet.
